



Background

UT-ORII's mission is to elevate the reputation of UT and ORNL through joint research and education programs

- Long history of ORNL/UT collaborations
- Complex set of siloed engagements
- Opportunity to increase impact by coordinating programs
- Opportunity to leverage significant support from State of Tennessee and DOE
- UT-ORII established on July 15, 2020, through a MOU between the UT System and ORNL

Financial drivers for UT-ORII

Our ambitious goals are underpinned by strong support from the state and other partners

- State investment is intended to drive long-term economic development in Tennessee
- These resources are viewed as seed funds; in all cases, we need to develop sustained external funding
- Convergent Research Initiatives were chosen with strong expected ROI

\$20M DOE EERE (workforce dev.)

>\$10M annual funds from state of TN

Leveraging ORNL + UT strengths to tackle some of world's biggest STEM challenges and bring new funds to Tennessee

- New research staff at ORNL/research faculty at UT
- LDRD investments at ORNL



UTK Science Alliance

THEC Center of Excellence with funds spent at UTK to encourage & develop collaborations with ORNL

- \$2.2M awarded in AY24-25
- > \$30M in external proposals submitted to date
- Seed projects aligned with UT-ORII CRIs
- GATE fellowships to high performing PhD students



Graduate education

Attracting the best and brightest

- Strategic goal: 500 PhD students participating with UT-ORII and ORNL by 2028
- UT-ORII manages the UT-ORNL Bredesen Center with 3 PhD programs (Energy Science and Engineering, Data Science and Engineering, Genome Science and Technology)
- Facilitate growth in other UT graduate programs via interactions with ORNL
- Financial support for new students for 1 year, then advisors support students
- 265 UT PhD students in Bredesen Center or other departments received UT-ORII funding in AY24-25

SMaRT Summer Internship Program



- 10-week program of hands-on research at UT and ORNL
- 40 undergraduate interns in summer 2025
- Students from 28 different universities (5 in TN and 23 out of state)

Ready! Set! Stemovate!






- Sixth-grade pilot completed in Cocke, Cumberland, Overton, Crockett counties – 350 students

- Planning state-wide expansion in partnership with UTB
