

Understand Your Responsibilities:

Disclosures to Sponsors



RESEARCH

An important aspect of research security is disclosures to sponsors. Federal agencies and some other sponsors require disclosure of support, interests, activities, and affiliations, even when they may appear unrelated to the research that they sponsor. This is in addition to disclosing outside interests to the University. Most interests and affiliations do not pose risks to research projects, but all are required to be disclosed.

- Create ORCID ID.
- Create SciENCv Biographical Sketch/Current & Pending (Other) Support documents.
